LAKE MURRAY TENNIS CLUB BOARD MEETING AUGUST 21, 2017

The balance in our savings account with North Island Credit Union is \$97,884.08. Jody will provide an itemized expense sheet next month.

MEMBERSHIP: Tom Sidley reported that as of today we have 325 memberships and 471 members. There was a discussion of how we might increase our membership. However, our overall membership is not too far off from last year.

LEAGUES: Nanette Herbuveaux reported that USTA coordinator, Randi Lettington, has two new leagues starting next week. There is a USTA Mixed Tri-Level League a mixed doubles league starting at 12:30 on Saturdays. Lake Murray is not involved in either one of these leagues at this time.

PRESIDENT: Ernie Kovacs reported that we are still trying to find a solution to the court reservation procedures so that people don't have to leave a message. Kathy Emmerson will call Balboa to see how they handle their reservations.

A trophy for Don Goss was found in the clubhouse and Ernie took it to give it to Don.

Ernie pointed out how much Graham Hilton contributes to our club. He does not charge us labor for any of the work he does around the club. He is indispensable!

Ernie is going to call the City to ask them to clear the brush areas around the driveway.

San Diego Christian College wants to use our facilities again next year.

The stone bench that sits near the tables has broken. Ernie will see that it is broken up and taken away. After a discussion, it was decided we would not replace the bench because there is ample seating in that area.
