

LAKE MURRAY TENNIS CLUB
BOARD MEETING
JUNE 20, 2017

The meeting was called to order at 12:38PM by Ernie Kovacs, President, at Gus' Restaurant. Those present were Ernie Kovacs, President; Kaye Listug, Vice-President; Jody Iverson, Treasurer; Tom Sidley, Membership; Denise Stefanson, Social; Nan Herbuveaux, Leagues; Barbara Beedle, Secretary; Kathy Emmerson, Management and Debi Adcock, out-going League Director. A quorum was established.

The April minutes were reviewed. Denise Stefanson moved and Tom Sidley seconded the minutes be approved. Motion passed.

MEMBERSHIP: Tom Sidley report there was one new member last month.

PRESIDENT: Ernie Kovacs reported that the trees around the premises have been trimmed. The repairs to courts 7 and 8 have been completed. Apparently, the reason for the constant problem on these two courts is that the rebar was laid too close to the surface. Ernie reported there is still a leak in the irrigation water pipe and, therefore, there is no water pressure. Ernie also reported that the weeds need to be cut back again. Also, the plastic clips on the "Water Only" signs are still breaking. There has been a problem with members bringing their own tennis teachers to the club to use the courts for tennis lessons. Since we have contracts with our tennis pros, this is not allowed.

SOCIAL: Denise Stefanson reported there is interest in attending the Aviators on July 16. The tickets are \$30.40 each and it is at La Costa. Kathy Emmerson will send an eblast to the membership to sign up at the front desk if they are interested in attending.
